

INSTALLATION OF A SOUND PROOF WALL ON RUE SAINT-JACQUES

As part of the Turcot Project, the ministère des Transports du Québec closed rue Saint-Jacques between avenue Girouard and boulevard Décarie on March 21, 2015. The closure was necessary to enable the diversion of the Haut Saint-Pierre collector. Later on, the pont Saint-Jacques over autoroute Décarie will be demolished and rebuilt.

Soundproof wall

In order to reduce noise pollution during the work, a temporary soundproof wall will be erected on rue Saint-Jacques, between avenue Girouard and rue Addington, near the sidewalk located on the north side of the street. This five-metre high wall will be installed by April and will remain in place until the end of the reconstruction of pont Saint-Jacques, in fall 2017.

Recycling and waste collection

For the duration of the work, recycling and garbage must be left at the usual location, by the side of the road. The contractor will move them to an accessible collection area, at the corner of rues Addington and Saint-Jacques, and will bring the recycling bins back afterwards. The ministère des Transports will notify you of any changes.

- Solid waste collection
 - Collection on Tuesday and Friday nights (between 5 p.m. and 2 a.m.);
 - Leave at the usual location (street or alleyway) between 8 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. on collection day.
- Collection of bulky items
 - Collection on Friday nights (between 5 p.m. and 2 a.m.);
 - Leave bulky items at the usual location (street or alleyway) between 8 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. on collection day.
- Recycling collection
 - Collection on Tuesdays during the day (between 7 a.m. and 6 p.m.);
 - Leave the recycling bin between 9 p.m. the night before and 7 a.m. on the morning of collection day.

It is important to comply with the above schedules and to clearly indicate your address on your recycling bin.
