

## DISMANTLING RAMP OF RUE SAINT-JACQUES TO AUTOROUTE 720 EAST

As part of Turcot Project work, the dismantling of the ramp of rue Saint-Jacques to eastbound autoroute 720 will be completed during January 2016.

This requires various closures on local road network and highway network starting from **January 8, 2016**.

### Work schedule

Dismantling work will be carried out during daytime **from January 8 to January 17, 2016**. After, the workers will proceed to the collection of materials and to the demobilization of the worksite.

### Mitigation measures

The Ministère is aware of the inconveniences that this work may cause, but the public is assured that all measures are being implemented to complete it as efficiently as possible. These measures include:

- Using hydraulic shears to minimize noise.
- Noise monitoring by onsite teams to ensure that authorized levels are respected.

### Traffic hindrances

#### → Weekend of January 8, 2016\*

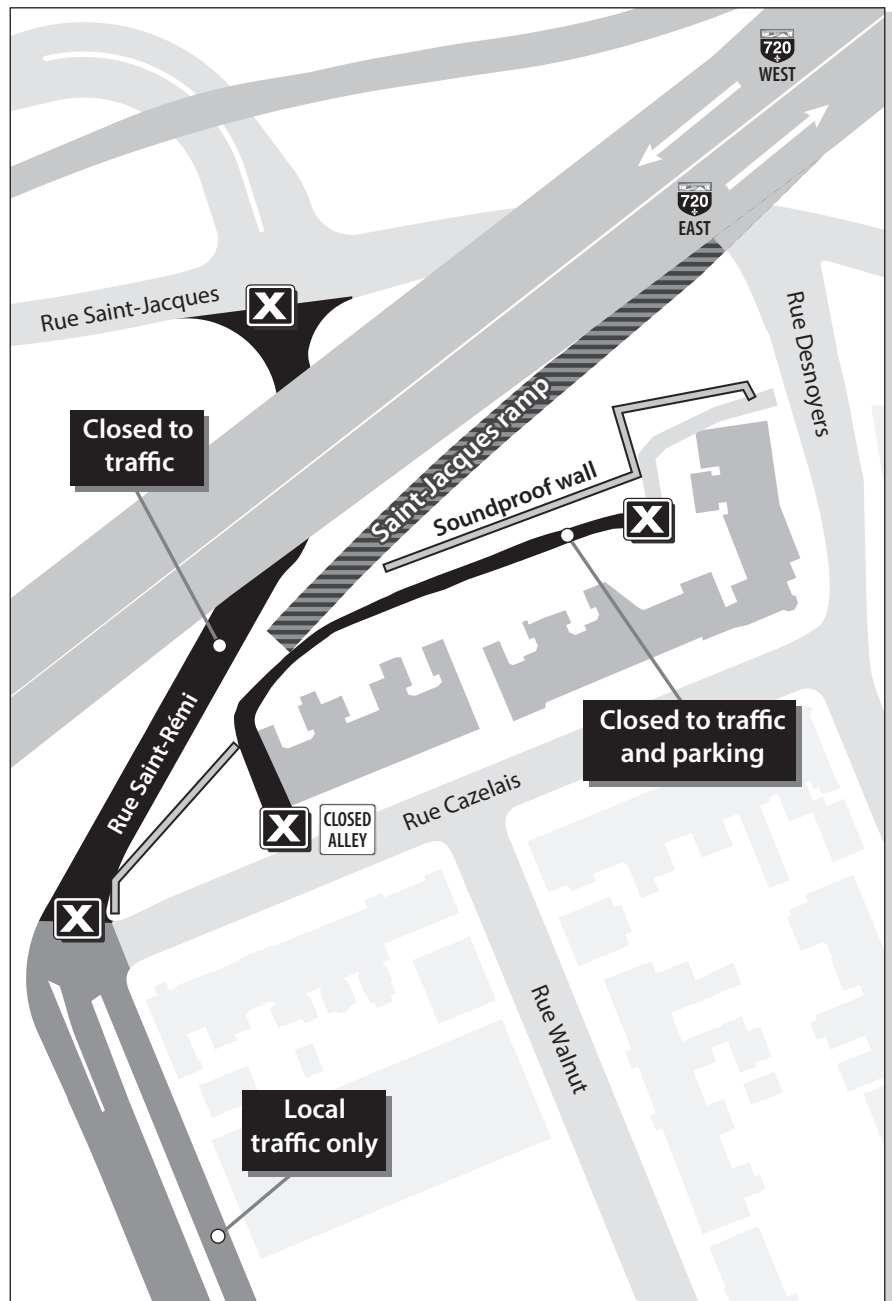
- Closure of rue Saint-Rémi between rues Notre-Dame Ouest et Saint-Jacques, **from Friday 8 p.m. to Monday 5 a.m.** Local traffic will be allowed between rues Notre-Dame Ouest and Cazalais.

\* These hindrances may also be required for the next weekend depending of the progress of work.

#### → From January 8, 2016 until the end of the month

- Closure of the alley on the north side of rue Cazalais. During this period, parking in the alley will be prohibited.

Signed detours will be in place.
