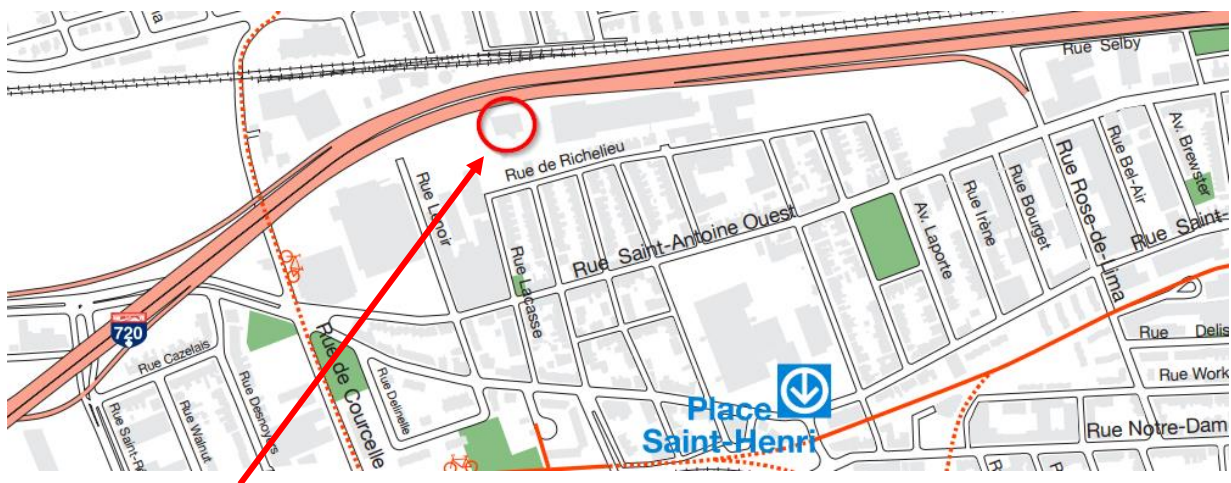


DISMANTLING OF 4295, RUE DE RICHELIEU

January 25, 2016 – As part of Turcot Project work, the dismantling of the building located on 4295, rue De Richelieu will start during the week of February 1st, 2016. This work, to be completed by the end of March 2016, is necessary to build the new route 136 (now autoroute 720).

Work Schedule

Work will be carried out mainly during daytime, from Monday to Friday, from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Exceptionally, some work may be carried out at night or during the weekend.

Mitigation Measures

The Ministère is aware of the inconveniences that this work may cause, but the public is assured that all measures are being implemented to complete it as efficiently as possible. These measures include:

- Minimalizing the use of an hydraulic hammer to encourage the use of an hydraulic jaw instead;
- Using as long as possible the building facade as a noise barrier;
- Noise monitoring by onsite teams to ensure that authorized levels are respected.

To encourage sustainable development, at least 80 % of the building components will be recycled.

No traffic hindrance will be put in place.
