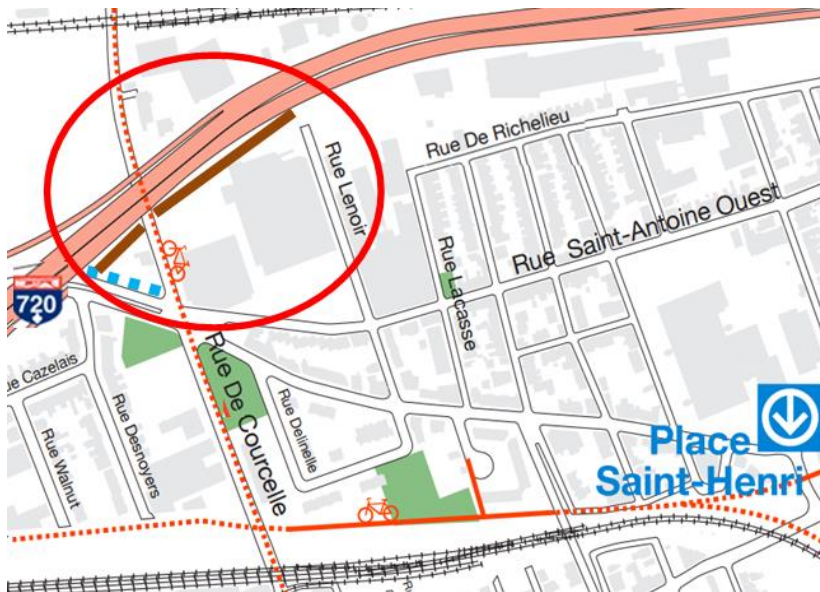


## REHABILITATION WORK –RUE DE COURCELLE AREA

**January 29, 2016** – Since the end of 2015, rehabilitation work is taking place in the De Courcelle area, near autoroute 720 (Ville-Marie). This work, which will be carried out until spring 2016, consists of the construction of an underground confining engineered wall used to confine contaminated soil.

Some noise levels higher than usual may occur. Vibrations may be felt in buildings located near the worksite.

### Work Schedule

Work will be carried out mainly during daytime, from Monday to Friday, from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Exceptionally, some work may be carried out at night or during the weekend.

### Mitigation Measures

The Ministère is aware of the inconveniences that this work may cause, but the public is assured that all measures are being implemented to complete it as efficiently as possible. These measures include:

- Installation of a temporary noise barrier along rue Saint-Antoine Ouest/Saint-Jacques;
- Installation of vibration dampers on the equipment;
- Noise and vibration monitoring by teams on site.
