



RECONSTRUCTION OF LACHINE CANAL BRIDGE

February 9, 2016 – As part of Turcot Project, the Lachine Canal bridge will be rebuilt. Work on the foundation elements began during the week of February 1st, 2016 and will continue until late spring 2016. Vibrations may be felt in the buildings located near the worksite.

Work Schedule

Work will be carried out mainly during daytime, from Monday to Friday, from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Exceptionally, some work may be carried out at night or during the weekend.

Mitigation measures

The Ministère is aware of the inconveniences that this work may cause, but reassures the public that all measures are implemented to complete it as efficiently as possible. These measures include:

- Installation of a temporary noise barrier along the worksite;
- Realization of the work mainly during the day;
- Exterior inspections of the buildings located within 100 meters of the worksite (spring 2015);
- Noise and vibrations monitoring by onsite teams to ensure that authorized levels are respected.
