

## PERMANENT CLOSURE OF A PARKING AREA COMPLEXE RÉCRÉATIF GADBOIS

As part of Turcot Project, the parking area of complexe récréatif Gadbois located south of rue Notre-Dame Ouest (see the map below) will be closed definitively starting March 21, 2016. This existing parking area is required for the reconstruction of Turcot interchange as the construction of a new ramp, the relocalisation of Turcot Holding spur track and the reconstruction of a section of rue Notre-Dame Ouest.

Users can use the parking located on the north side of rue Notre-Dame Ouest. During the next months, a new access to complexe récréatif Gadbois will be built from rue Notre-Dame Ouest (see the map below). Until the opening, the access of alley Gadbois from rue Notre-Dame Ouest will be closed.

Note that the main entrance (chemin de la Côte-Saint-Paul) and the entrance of the arena will remain open at all times.
