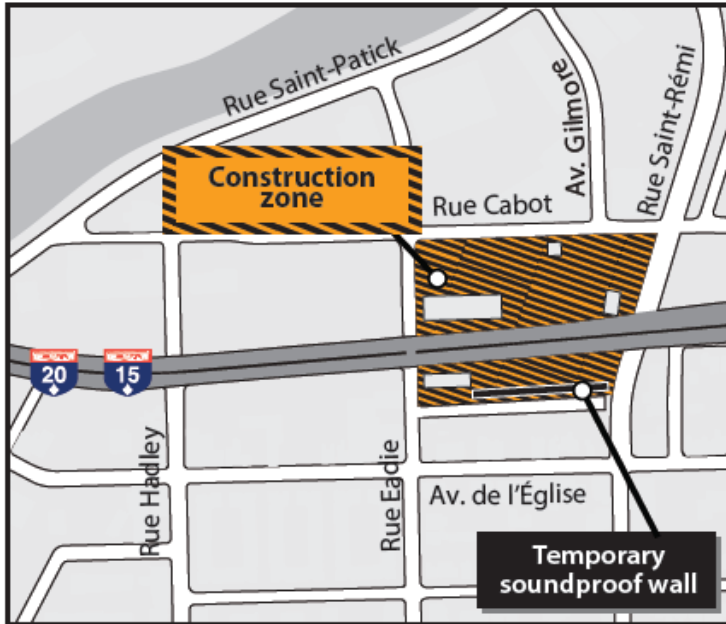


DISMANTLING OF 1868, RUE CABOT

April 18, 2016 - The ministère des Transports, de la Mobilité durable et de l'Électrification des transports would like to inform the public that the dismantling of the former ecocenter of Ville de Montréal, located to 1868, rue Cabot, will start on April 25, 2016. This work, to be completed at the end of May, is required to construct the new infrastructures of autoroute 15 in the area.



Work Schedule

Dismantling will be carried out mainly during daytime, from Monday to Friday, from 6 am to 7 pm. Exceptionally, it may be carried at night and during the weekend.

Hindrance

Closure of rue Eadie between rue Cabot and avenue de l'Église for a few days during this period.

Once confirmed, dates will be posted on the Turcot website.

Mitigation measures

The Ministère is aware of the inconveniences that this work may cause, but the public is assured that all measures are being implemented to complete it as efficiently as possible. These measures include:

- Frequent watering to minimize dust emission
- Installation of a temporary noise barrier on the south side of autoroute 15 (as shown above)
- Minimalizing the use of an hydraulic hammer to use of an hydraulic jaw instead
- Noise monitoring by onsite team.

To encourage sustainable development, at least 80 % of the building components will be recycled.
