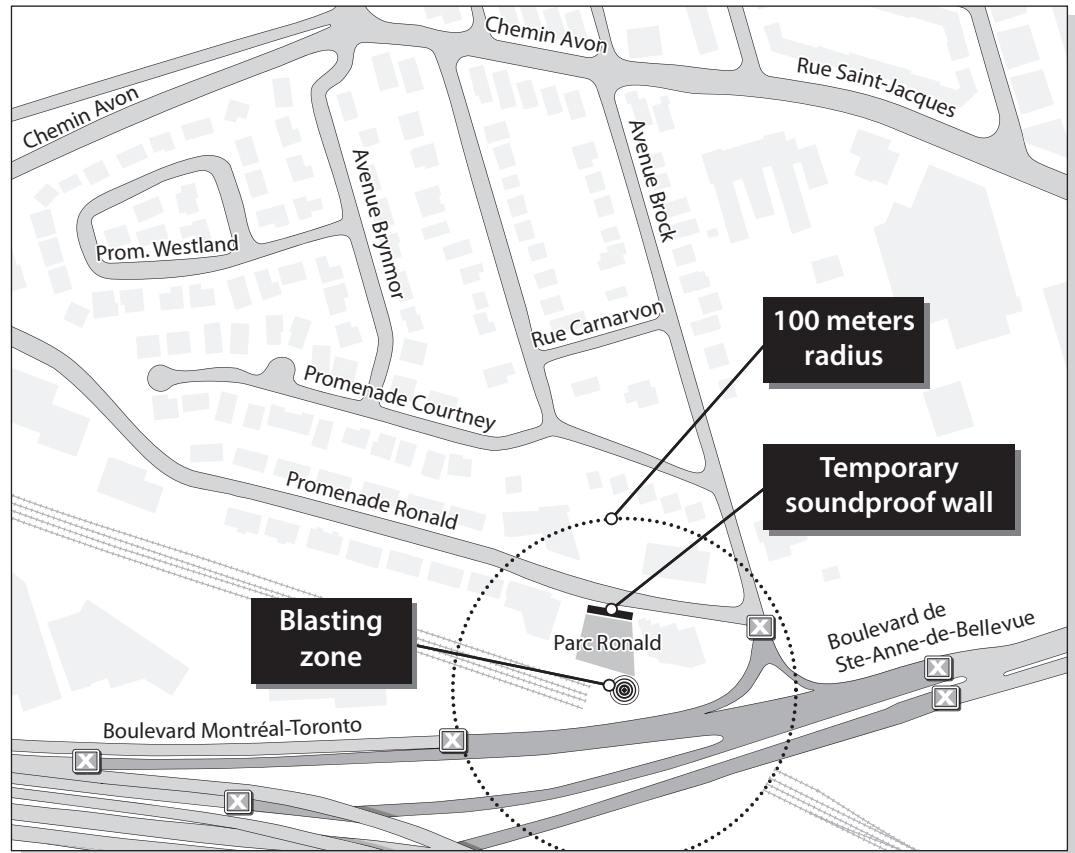


## BLASTING WORK

As part of Turcot Project, blasting work, originally planned for mid-March, will take place between **March 31<sup>st</sup> and April 8, 2016** in the parc Ronald area. This work, which includes several blasts, will shatter rock to replace a drainage conduit and, in the same time, to limit inconveniences (duration, vibrations and noise levels) on residents living in the area.

### Safety measures

- A fence will delimit the construction area
- Installation of carbon monoxide detectors, before work begins, in buildings located within a distance of 100 meters
- Installation of a blasting mat over rock to contain the projection of rock
- Display of safety measures around the worksite



### Steps for each blasting

1. Twelve short alarms will be heard
2. Blasting
3. One longer final alarm to indicate that blasting is over and that the zone is secure

When blasting will occur, vibrations may be felt during a few seconds. Noise level will be higher during deflagrations.

### Work Schedule

Work will be carried out during daytime, **from Monday to Friday, from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.**
