

WORK NEAR AUTOROUTE 15 NORTH BETWEEN RUES SAINT-JACQUES AND SHERBROOKE OUEST

March 30, 2016 – As part of Turcot project, a temporary configuration will be built along autoroute 15 (Décarie) northbound, between rues Saint-Jacques and Sherbrooke Ouest, during the **next six weeks**. This work will eventually allow the deviation of traffic in the Turcot Interchange during the reconstruction of the new ramp of autoroute 15 southbound to the future route 136 (now autoroute 720).

This may produce noise levels higher than usual during particular operations. Vibrations may be felt in buildings located near the worksite.

Work Schedule

During this period, work will take place 24/7.

Mitigation Measures

The Ministère is aware of the inconveniences that this work may cause, but the public is assured that all measures are being implemented to complete it as efficiently as possible. These measures include:

- Carrying out noisy work mainly during the day;
- Installation of muffler or acoustic enclosure on some equipment (e.g.: rubber on doors of dumpers);
- Noise and vibrations monitoring by team onsite to ensure that the authorized noise levels are respected.
