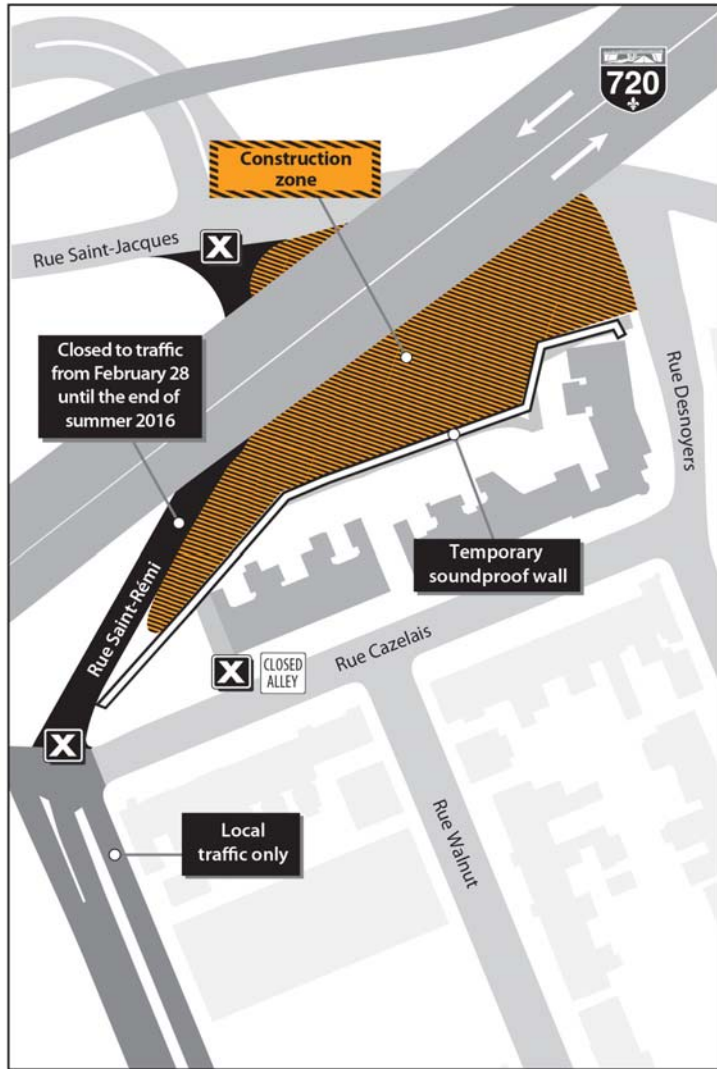


## CONTINUOUS WORK NEAR RUES CAZELAIS AND DESNOYERS

**April 1st, 2016** – As part of Turcot Project, the construction of route 136 (now autoroute 720) requires carrying out continuous work north of rue Cazelaïs between **April 4 and April 18, 2016**. This work is also necessary to build the overpass of route 136 that will be spanning rue Saint-Jacques.

Noise levels higher than usual may occur during some operations. Vibrations may be felt in buildings located near the worksite.



### FROM APRIL 4 TO APRIL 18, 2016

General excavation will be carried out to prepare the structure foundation parts.

#### Work Schedule

During this period, work will be carried out **24 / 7**.

Work during the weekend will be ongoing beyond April 18, mainly during the day.

#### Mitigation Measures

The Ministère is aware of the inconveniences that this work may cause, but the public is assured that all measures are being implemented to complete it as efficiently as possible. These measures include:

- Installation of a temporary noise barrier along the worksite area;
- Carrying out noisy work mainly during the day;
- Installation of muffler or acoustic enclosure on some equipment (e.g.: rubber on doors of dumpers, decreasing the volume of backup alarms);
- Noise and vibrations monitoring by team onsite to ensure that the authorized noise levels are respected.
