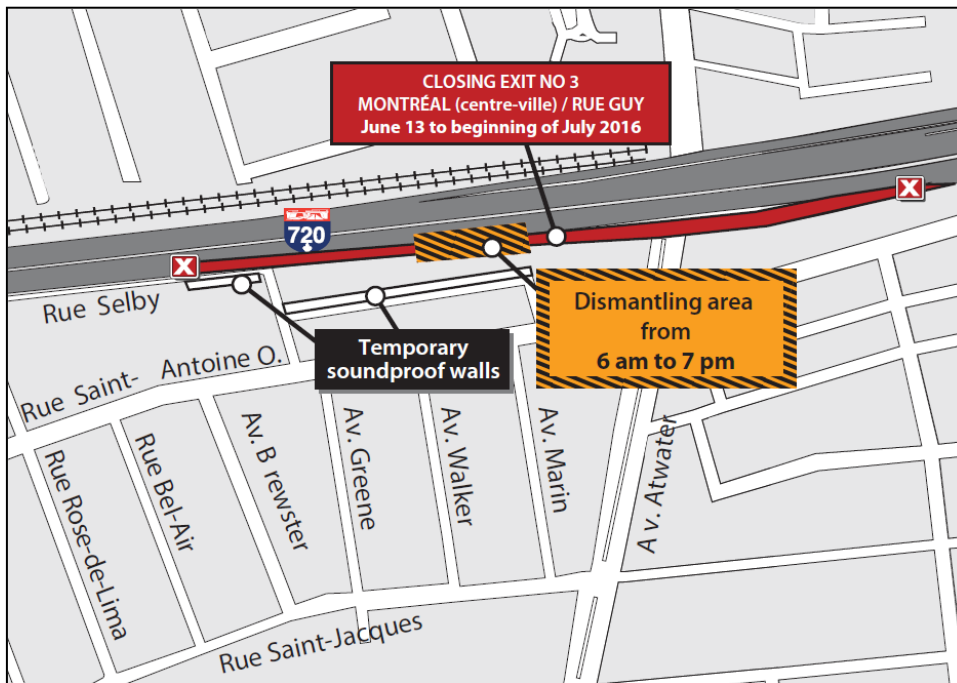


DISMANTLING WORK

June 7, 2016 - Le ministère des Transports, de la Mobilité durable et de l'Électrification des transports would like to inform the public that dismantling work will be carried out in the area starting from June 13, 2016. Noise levels higher than usual may occur and vibrations may be felt in buildings located near the work area.



From June 13 to the beginning of July 2016

Dismantling of the parapet of exit n° 3 – rue Guy, Montréal (Downtown) of A-720 eastbound.

Work Schedule

Dismantling work will be carried out from Monday to Friday between 6 am and 7 pm.

Some work, carried out at night and on the weekend, is also ongoing in the area until the end of July 2016. It will be ongoing beyond the end of July, mainly during the day between 6 am and 7 pm.

Mitigation Measures

The Ministère is aware of the inconveniences that this work may cause, but the public is assured that all measures are being implemented to complete it as efficiently as possible. These measures include:

- Installation of temporary noise barriers south of autoroute 720
- Avoiding using equipment causing higher noise levels
- Using water cannon to control dust emission and dispersion
- Noise and vibration monitoring by teams on site
