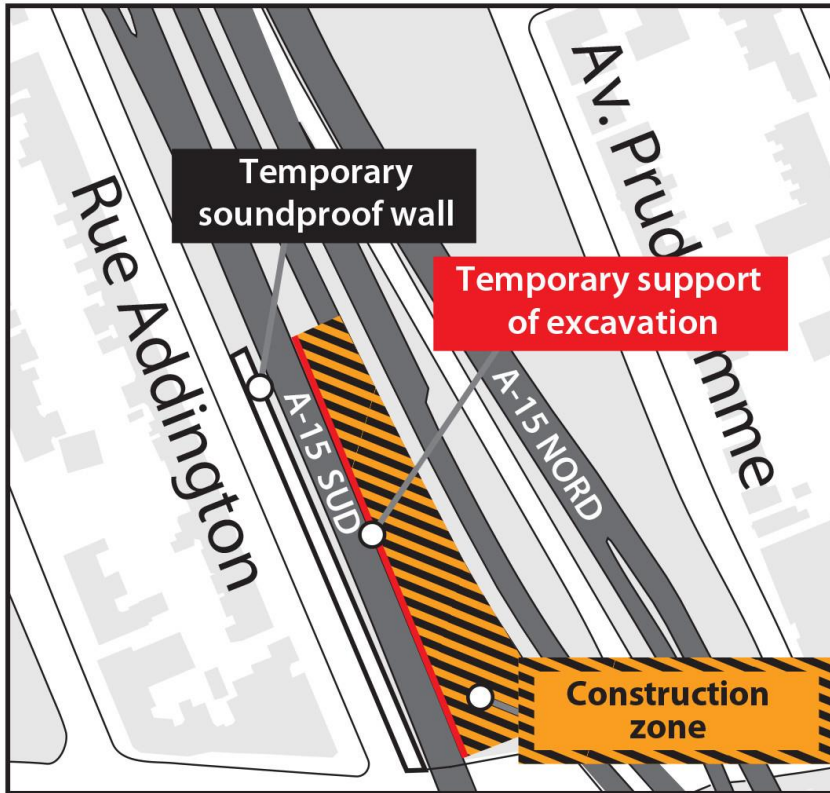


CONSTRUCTION OF NEW INFRASTRUCTURES – NIGHT WORK

June 29, 2016 - The ministère des Transports, de la Mobilité durable et de l'Électrification des transports would like to inform the public that starting from July 5, 2016, work will be carried out at night and on the weekend in your area. Some noise levels higher than usual may occur.



From July 5 to end of September, 2016

Construction of a temporary retaining wall and excavation work to build the new ramp of autoroute 15 southbound towards route 136 eastbound.

Work Schedule

During this period, work will be carried out 24/7.

Work will be ongoing beyond the end of September, 2016 and mainly during the day.

Hindrance

On July 7 and 8, 2016, a section of rue Addington will be closed to traffic between 7:30 and 4:30 to set up a noise barrier. Parking will be forbidden during this period.

Mitigation Measures

The Ministère is aware of the inconveniences that this work may cause, but the public is assured that all measures are being implemented to complete it as efficiently as possible. These measures include:

- Setting up noise mitigation measures on some equipment (interdiction of slamming doors of dump trucks, lowering backup alarm volume);
- Installation of a temporary noise barrier along a section of rue Addington (as shown above);
- Noise and vibration monitoring by teams onsite;
