

## CONSTRUCTION OF THE NEW EXIT RUE ATWATER

**July 6, 2016** - The ministère des Transports, de la Mobilité durable et de l'Électrification des transports would like to inform the residents that dismantling work will be carried out in your area starting from July 11, 2016.



### From July 11 until November 2016

- Dismantling of the infrastructures of the exit rue Atwater starting from July 11, for approximately 6 weeks.
- Construction of the new exit rue Atwater exit until November 2016.

### Work Schedule

Work will be carried out every day, between 7 am and 5:30 pm.

The regular work hours in your area are from 6 am to 7 pm. Certain work will be carried out at night and during the weekend.

### Mitigation Measures

The Ministère is aware of the inconveniences that this work may cause, but the public is assured that all measures are being implemented to complete it as efficiently as possible. These measures include:

- Setting up noise mitigation measures on some equipment (interdiction of slamming doors of dump trucks, lowering backup alarm volume);
- Installation of noise barriers along the work site area
- Noise and vibration monitoring by team on site
- Water spreading during dismantling to limit dust emission and dispersion

### Hindrance

From July 11, 10:30 pm until November 2016, exit no 2 – rue Atwater of autoroute 720 eastbound will be completely closed to traffic. Users will have to take the next exit.
