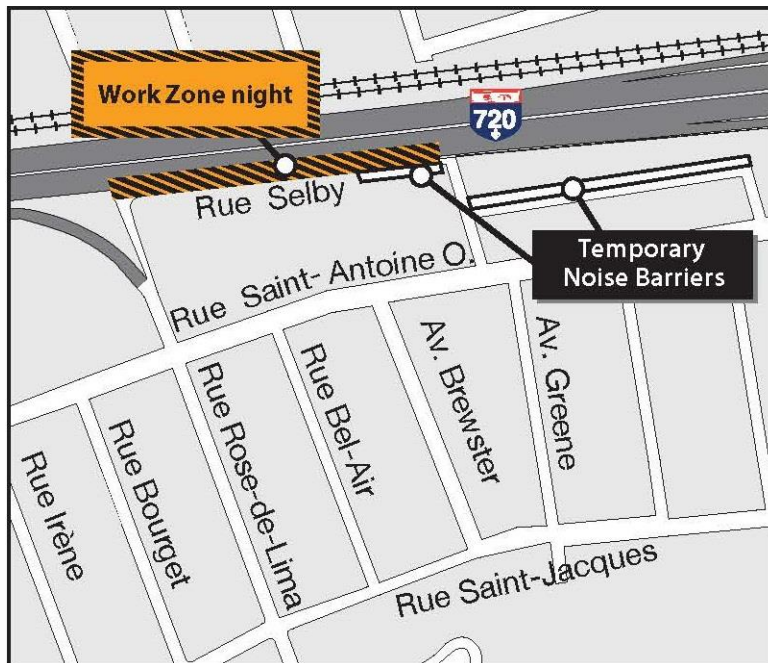


CONSTRUCTION OF ROUTE 136

PROLONGATION OF WORK CARRIED OUT AT NIGHT UNTIL THE END OF SUMMER 2016

July 27, 2016 - The ministère des Transports, de la Mobilité durable et de l'Électrification des transports would like to inform the public that work carried out at night and during the weekend, ongoing since May 26, in the area will be completed at the end of the summer. Note that the construction of the autoroute 720 temporary deviation is necessary to build the new route 136 replacing the existing highway.

During certain operation, noise level higher than usual may occur.

Work Schedule

During this period, work will be carried out 24/7.

Work will be ongoing beyond the end of summer, 2016 and mainly during the day, between 6 am and 7 pm.

Mitigation Measures

The Ministère is aware of the inconveniences that this work may cause, but the public is assured that all measures are being implemented to complete it as efficiently as possible. These measures include:

- Setting up noise mitigation measures on some equipment, e.g. interdiction of slamming doors of dump trucks,);
- Installation of a temporary noise barrier on the south side of autoroute 720 (as shown above);
- Noise and vibration monitoring by teams onsite;
- Restricting work carried out at night that may cause higher vibration and noise levels.
