

CLOSURE OF A SECTION OF RUE EADIE

August 3, 2016 - The ministère des Transports, de la Mobilité durable et de l'Électrification des transports would like to inform the public that a section of rue Eadie will be closed to traffic starting from August 10, 2016 until the end of September 2016. This closure is necessary to carry out excavation and drainage work to build the new infrastructures of autoroute 15.



From August 10, 2016, 8 pm to end of September 2016

- Complete closure of rue Eadie between rue Cabot and avenue de l'Église
- Local traffic and parking allowed in rue Eadie between autoroute 15 and avenue de l'Église
- Closure of the sidewalk on the North side
- Detour indicated with road signs by rues Saint-Patrick et Saint-Rémi

Work Schedule

The regular work hours in this area are from 6 am to 7 pm. Some work may be carried out at night and during the weekend.

Mitigation Measures

The Ministère is aware of the inconveniences that this work may cause, but the public is assured that all measures are being implemented to complete it as efficiently as possible. These measures include:

- Setting up noise mitigation measures on some equipment (interdiction of slamming doors of dump trucks)
- Noise and vibration monitoring by teams onsite
- Installation of two noise stations in the work area. Results are available at any time on the Turcot website (www.turcot.gouv.qc.ca)
- Continuous sweeping and cleaning of the streets in the work area
