

## CONSTRUCTION OF ROUTE 136 IN YOUR AREA

**September 6, 2016** - The ministère des Transports, de la Mobilité durable et de l'Électrification des transports would like to inform the public about work in progress and work to come in your area. Note that work carried out at night and during the weekend is necessary for certain operations.

- Until November 2016 :
  - construction of the first two lanes of route 136 est
- November 2016 to 2018 :
  - diverting the traffic of the autoroute 720 est on the two new lanes of route 136 est
  - dismantling of the existing autoroute 720 est
  - construction of the two additional lanes of the new route 136 est

### Mitigation Measures

The Ministère is aware of the inconveniences that this work may cause, but the public is assured that all measures are being implemented to complete it as efficiently as possible. These measures include:

- Putting in place noise mitigation measures on some equipment (ex.: interdiction of slamming doors of dump trucks, limiting speed on equipment)
- Installation of temporary noise barrier on the south side of autoroute 720
- Setting up sound level monitoring stations in the area (results available online at [www.turcot.gouv.qc.ca](http://www.turcot.gouv.qc.ca))
- Awareness of the workers on the site
- Limiting work carried out at night that might cause higher noise levels
