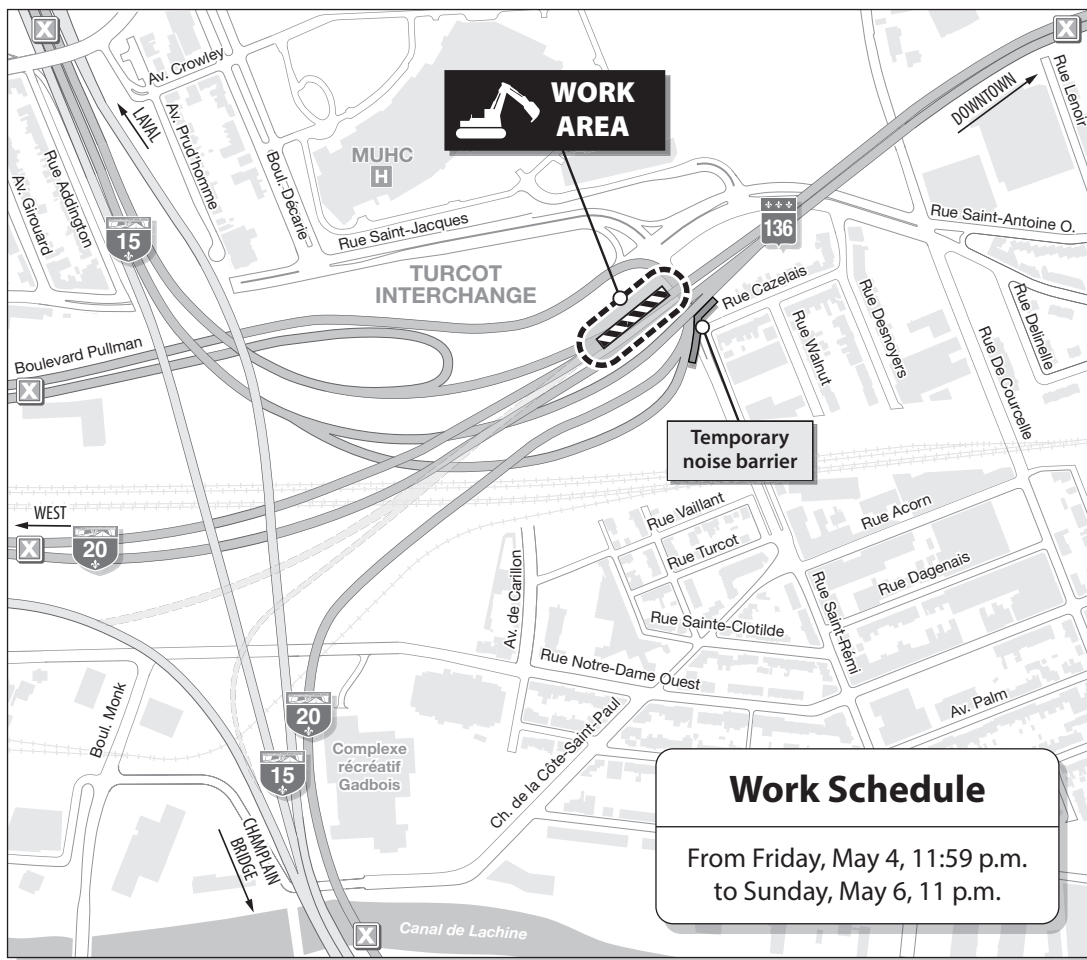


# Notice to residents

The ministère des Transports, de la Mobilité durable et de l'Électrification des transports wishes to inform you that **dismantling operations will be carried out continuously during the weekend of May 4** in the heart of the Turcot interchange. This work may be audible from your home.



## Work Description

Dismantling of an out of service ramp of the Turcot interchange.

## Sound Climate

Due to the nature of the operations to be carried out, and the constraints limiting the mitigation measures that can be implemented, the allowed noise levels for the weekend will exceed the thresholds normally allowed. **They could reach up to 79 dB.**

## Mitigation Measures

- Use of water cannons to limit dust dispersion
- Use less noisy back-up alarms on certain equipment used at night
- Noise monitoring by the team on site
