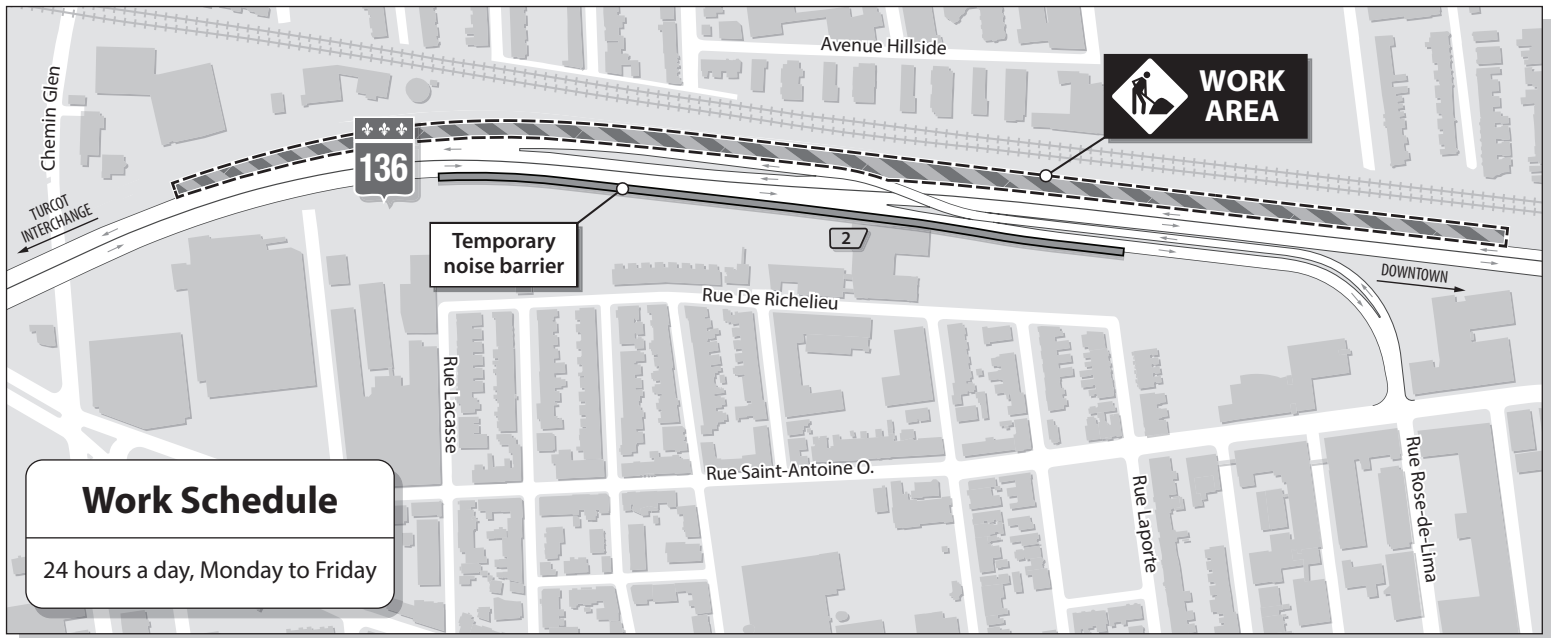


Notice to residents

The ministère des Transports, de la Mobilité durable et de l'Électrification des transports wishes to inform you that **there will be ongoing work in your area from the end of May until the end of the summer of 2018** to continue the construction of route 136 ouest.

This work could result in higher noise levels than usual.



Sound Climate

Due to the nature of the operations to be carried out, the equipment required and the constraints limiting the mitigation measures that can be implemented, the noise levels allowed for these operations will exceed the thresholds normally allowed. **They could reach up to 70 dB, Monday to Friday, from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m.**
