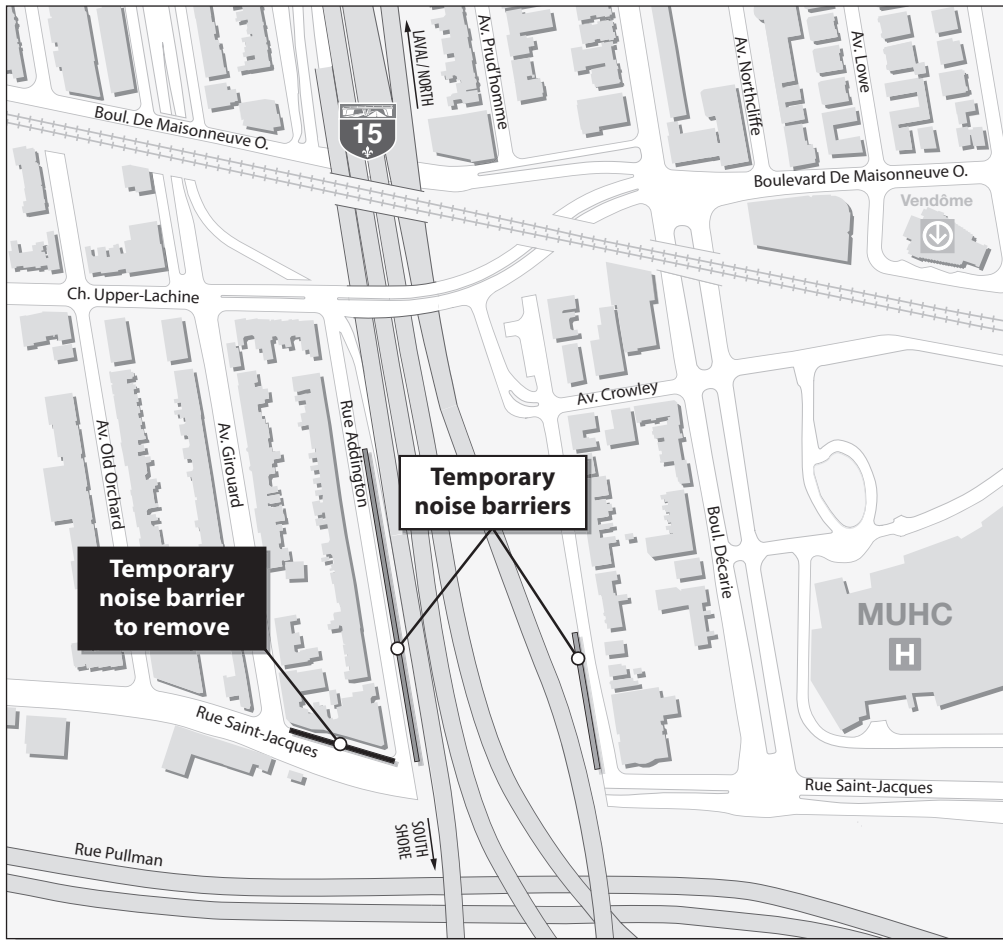


Notice to residents

The ministère des Transports, de la Mobilité durable et de l'Électrification des transports wishes to inform you that **the temporary noise barrier located along rue Saint-Jacques will be removed during the month of July.**



Work description

This work is necessary in order to carry out aqueduct and drainage works. Note that this work will not be as noisy and will take place mainly during the day. The noise barrier is no longer necessary and will be replaced by a construction fence to free the space and the view.

Construction of Saint-Jacques bridge

Future work will be performed mostly during the day:

- Pouring of concrete at the abutments, that is the support points of the deck, at each end of the bridge
- Installation of the remaining two sections of the deck
- Installation of the mast and stay cables
- Completion of the roadway and earthworks

Recycling and garbage collection

Despite the removal of the noise barrier, the contractor will continue to move your recycling and garbage into an accessible area for pickup. Your collaboration is requested to ensure the smooth running of the operations:

- Avoid overloading bags
- Group your recycling / waste in bags or bins provided for this purpose
