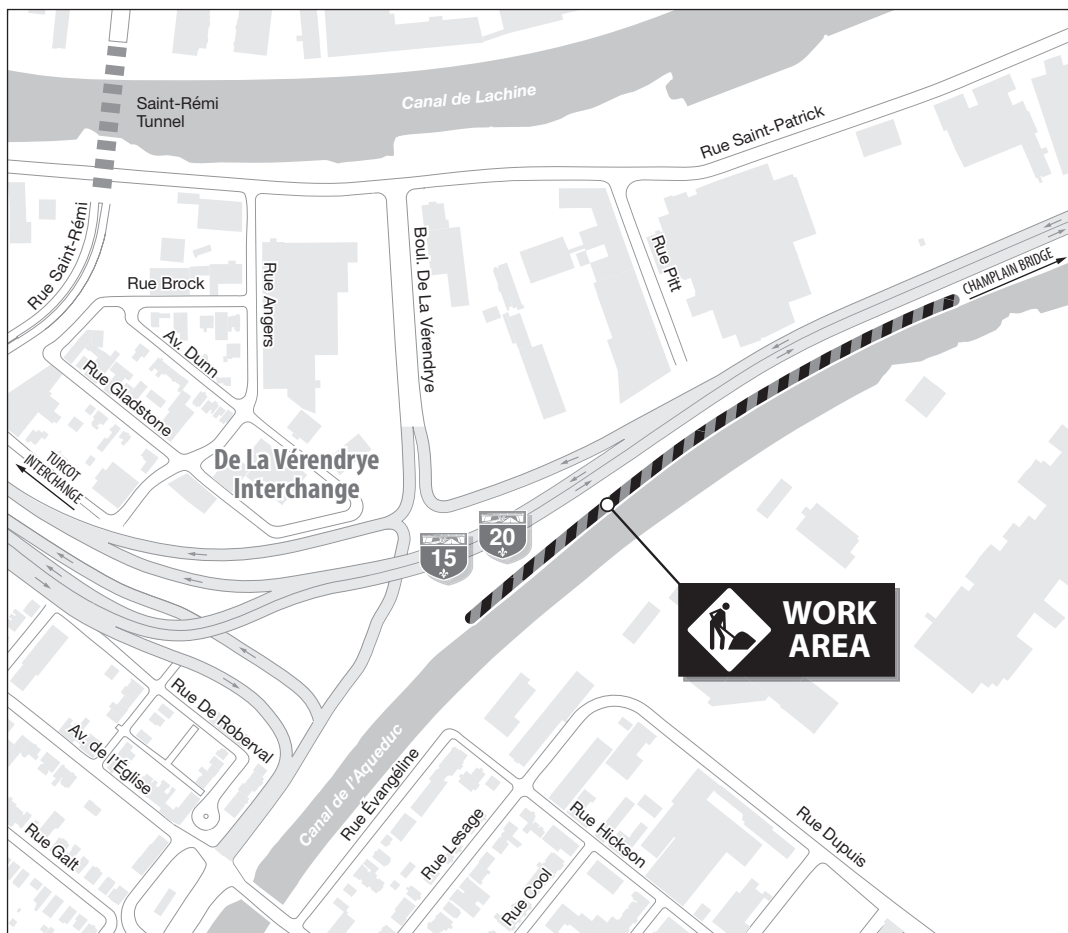




# Notice to residents

The ministère des Transports, de la Mobilité durable et de l'Électrification des transports wishes to inform you that **work that results in higher sound levels than usual will be realized in your area from mid-August to the end of September 2018.**



## Nature des travaux

Construction of autoroute 15 retaining wall along the canal de l'Aqueduc. The most noisy operations, the insertion of sheetpiles in the ground by small vibrations, will be carried out in increments of 15 minutes for a maximum of 2 hours per day.

## Work Schedule

Monday to Friday  
from 6:30 a.m. to 6:30 p.m.\*

\* Some work could be carried out until 9 p.m. or on the weekend, on an ad hoc basis.

## Climat sonore

Due to the nature of the operations to be carried out, the equipment required and the constraints limiting the mitigation measures that can be implemented, the noise levels allowed for these operations will exceed the thresholds normally allowed. **They could reach up to 84 dB.**

## Mesures d'atténuation

- Day and/or evening work
- Noise monitoring by the team on site
