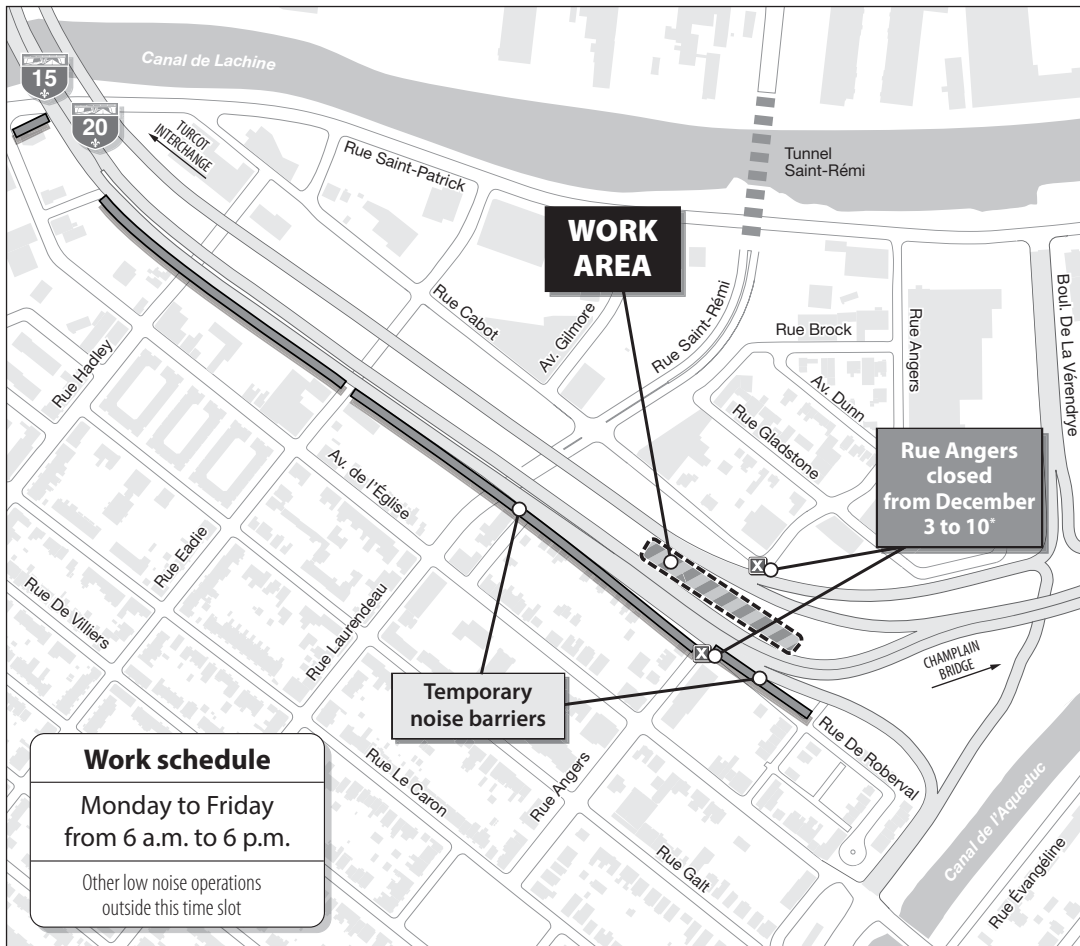


Notice to residents

The ministère des Transports wishes to inform you that dismantling operations will be carried out from the week of **November 26 to mid-December 2018** in your area.

This work will result in the **complete closure of rue Angers under autoroute 15 from December 3 to 10***.



*Note that the City of Montreal could maintain the closure for an additional week.

Work Description

Dismantling of the former entrance to autoroute 15 northbound from boulevard De La Vérendrye.

Noise Environment

Due to the nature of the operations, which include constraints such as the height of the structures to be dismantled and limited workspace, **the noise levels allowed may exceed the normally permitted thresholds.** They may reach 85 dBA.

Mitigation Measures

The Ministère is aware of the inconveniences this work may cause, but be assured that all measures are in place to reduce the impact on residents, including:

- Use of water/snow cannons to limit dust dispersion
- Implementation of noise mitigation measures on some vehicles and pieces of equipment
- Maintenance of temporary noise barriers
- Noise monitoring by the team on site
