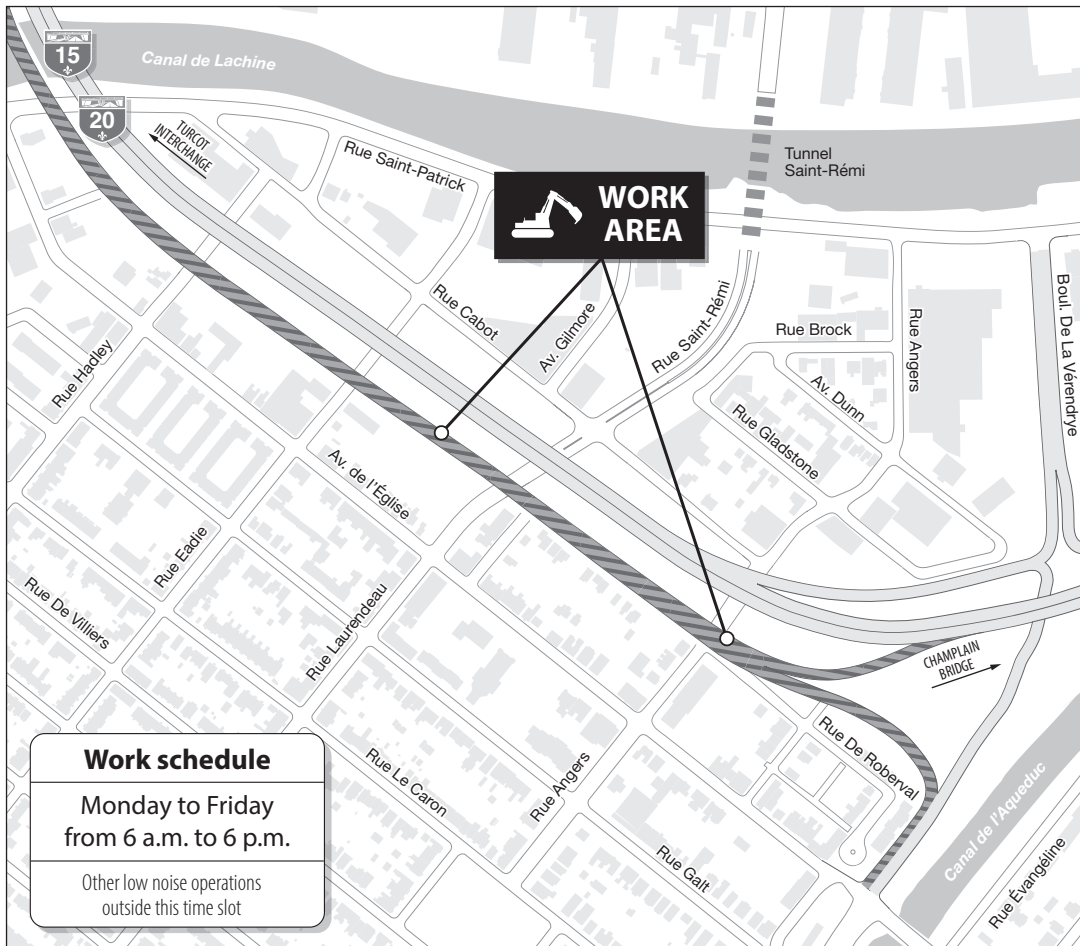




Notice to residents

The ministère des Transports wishes to inform you that dismantling operations of autoroute 15 southbound will be carried out **starting December 10, 2018, and will continue until spring 2019.**

Attend the Neighbourhood Committee meeting of December 5 to learn all the details of upcoming operations.



Noise Environment

Due to the nature of the operations, which include constraints such as the height of the structures to be dismantled and limited workspace, **the noise levels allowed could exceed the normally permitted thresholds.** They could reach 90 dBA.

Mitigation Measures

The Ministère is aware of the inconveniences this work may cause, but be assured that all measures are in place to reduce the impact on residents, including:

- Use of water/snow cannons to limit dust dispersion
- Implementation of noise mitigation measures on some vehicles and pieces of equipment

Due to limited space, temporary noise barriers will be removed and reinstalled by section based on operations.

Hindrances

Local street closures will be required at various times during the work including rue De Roberval, rue Angers and rue Laurendeau. Visit the Turcot website regularly for the latest information on traffic conditions.
