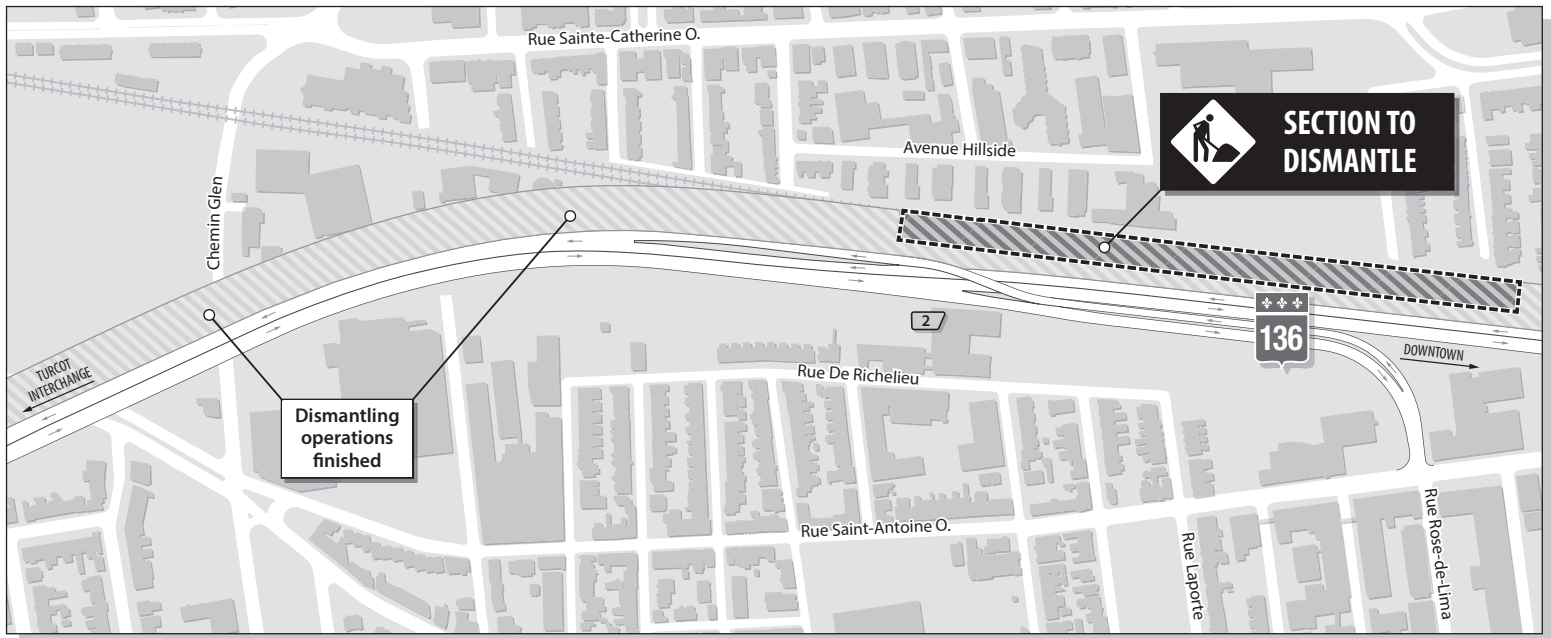


Notice to residents

The ministère des Transports wishes to inform you that **the last phase** of the **A-720 westbound** dismantling will begin on the weekend of **January 12, 2019**.
The work will continue until late March 2019.



Noise environment

Due to the nature of the operations to be performed, and constraints limiting mitigation measures, including the height of the structures to be dismantled and the restricted space in the area, the noise levels allowed will exceed the thresholds normally allowed. They could reach up to:

- From 6 a.m. to 9 p.m.: **85 dBA**
- From 9 p.m. to 11 p.m.: **75 dBA**

Mitigation Measures

The Ministère is aware of the inconveniences this work may cause, that is why every effort is being made to reduce the impacts on the residents, particularly:

- Dust abatement with water/snow cannons
- Noise monitoring by on-site teams
- Implementation of noise mitigation measures on certain equipment

Work Schedule

Monday to Friday	Saturday and Sunday
From 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. Dismantling operations	From 6 a.m. to 11 p.m. Dismantling operations
From 6 p.m. to 6 a.m. Handling and transport of debris	From 11 p.m. to 6 a.m. Handling and transport of debris

On top of weekdays work, four weekends will be needed (January 12-13, 19-20, and 26-27, as well as another weekend in mid-February). In the event of adverse weather conditions, these operations could be postponed.
