The ministère des Transports would like to inform the public that the **dismantling of old structures** of the Turcot interchange is **currently performed**. These operations will continue **until late April 2019**. The noise caused by these operations may be heard from your house.

The dismantling operations have to be carried out during **week-ends** as they **require major closures on the freeway network**.

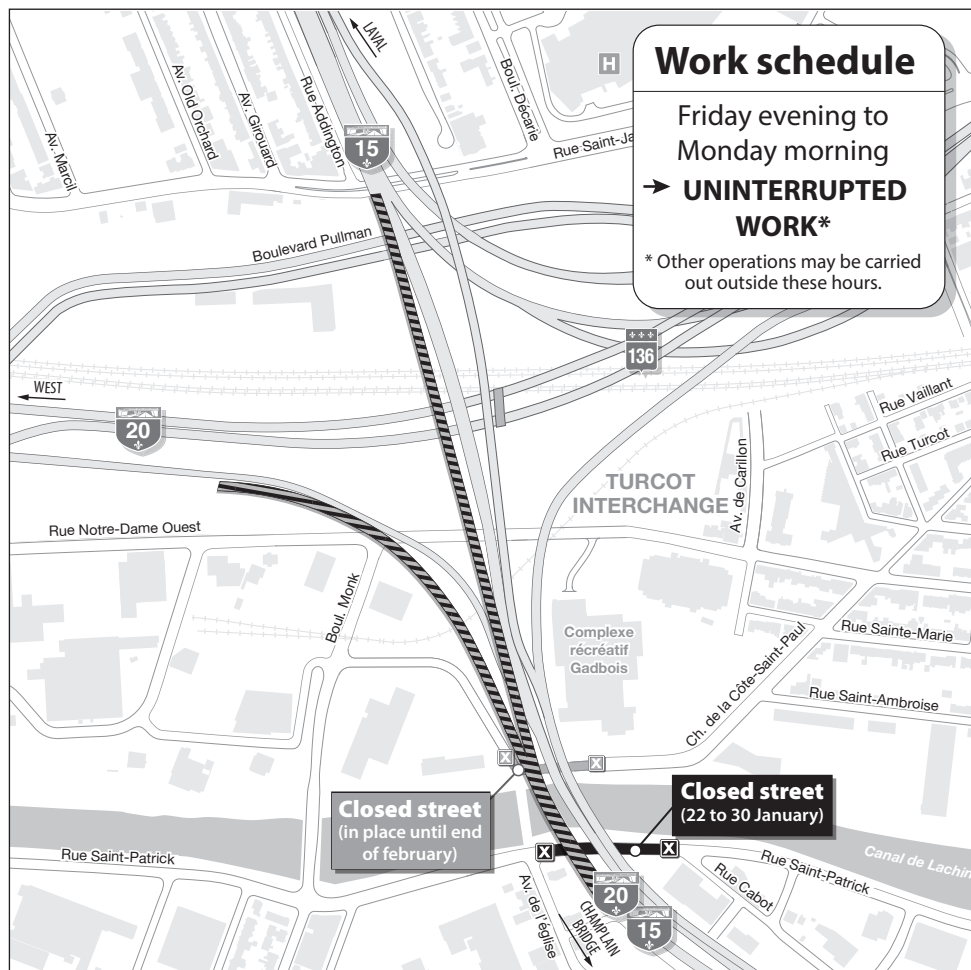
Mitigation Measures

The Ministère is aware of the inconveniences this work may cause, but rest assured that all necessary measures are implemented to reduce impacts on residents, namely:

- Dust abatement with water cannons
- Implementation of noise mitigation measures on some vehicles
- Noise monitoring by on-site teams

Closures: rue Saint-Patrick and multipurpose path

- Closure of rue Saint-Patrick to all users between avenue de l'Église and rue Cabot from **January 22, 10 p.m. to January 30**
