

Notice to residents

The ministère des Transports wishes to inform you that **reconstruction work** of highway 15 southbound will intensify in your area in the coming weeks and will carry on **until the end of fall 2019**.



Work Description

Ongoing until summer 2019:

- Excavation and earthworks – continuous operations

From February 11 to the beginning of March 2019:

- Dismantling of concrete barriers – night operations requiring the closure of highway 15 southbound

From mid-February to the end of April 2019:

- Drilling anchors for a temporary wall – day operations

From mid-March to the end of April 2019:

- Dismantling of a retaining wall by sawing – night operations requiring the closure of highway 15 southbound

Vibrations

Vibrations could be felt during certain operations, such as drilling.

Mitigation Measures

The Ministère is aware of the inconveniences this work may cause, that is why every effort is being made to reduce the impacts on the residents, particularly:

- Using low-noise backup alarms on certain pieces of equipment
- Noise and vibrations monitoring by the team on site
- Setting up of noise attenuation on some equipment
