

Notice to residents

Le ministère des Transports informs you of the **dismantling operations to be carried out** in the area over the next few weeks.

1 Dismantling in the Turcot interchange

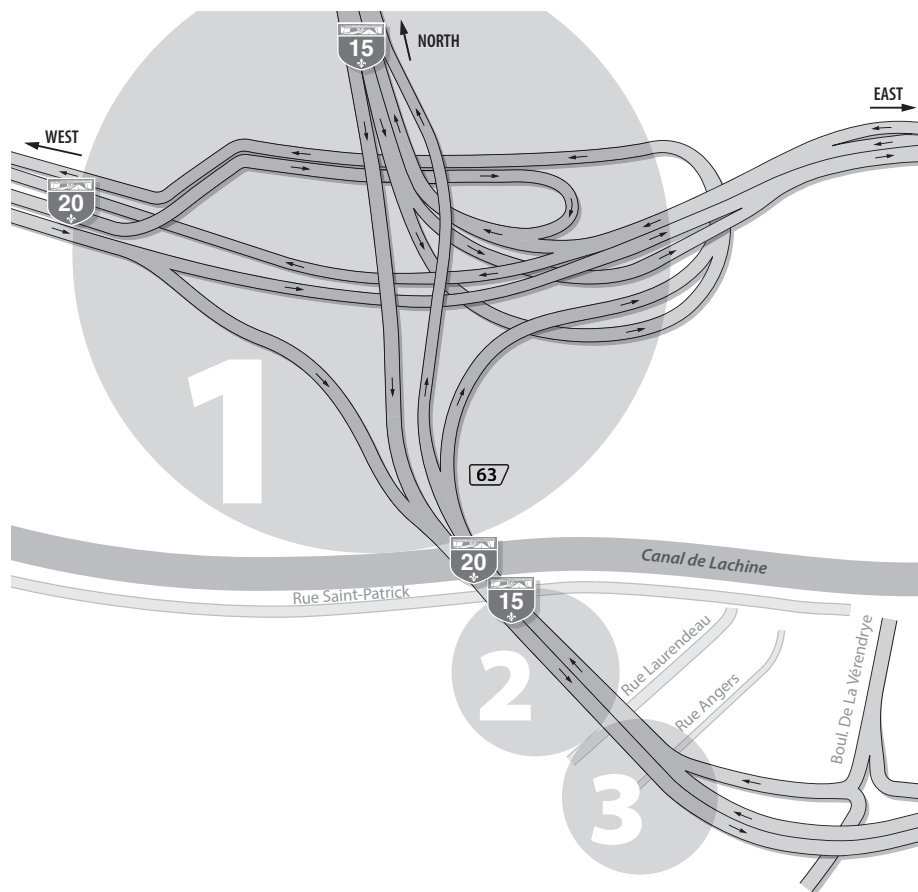
- These operations will be carried out continuously until **late May**. Although operations are performed quite far from residential areas, some noise may be heard from your house.

2 Between rue Saint-Patrick and rue Laurendeau

- Dismantling performed from **March 18 to late April**, on weekdays from **7 a.m. to 11 p.m.**
- Some operations could be carried out occasionally on weekends.

3 Rue Angers area

- Dismantling performed on the weekend of **March 16**, between **7 a.m. and 7 p.m.**
- Operations will be continued on weekdays from **7 a.m. to 7 p.m.** until **late March**.



Mitigation Measures

The Ministère is aware of the inconveniences this work may cause, but rest assured that all the necessary measures to mitigate impacts on residents are implemented, including:

- Dust suppression with water cannons
- Implementation of noise mitigation measures on some vehicles
- Noise monitoring by on-site teams

Noise environment

Due to the nature of operations and constraints, including the height of structures to dismantle, which limit possible mitigation measures, noise levels allowed will exceed the normally permitted thresholds.
