The ministère des Transports wishes to inform you that **the construction work on route 136 westbound will intensify in the coming weeks.** The work will be performed continuously, from Monday to Friday, until route 136 opens in late 2019.



Work and schedule

From the end of March to the summer of 2019

- **Between 6 a.m. and 7 p.m.:** Installation of the retaining wall panels
- **Between 7 p.m. and 6 a.m.:** Delivery of materials, placement of embankment and compaction operations

From the summer of 2019 to the end of 2019

- **Carried out continuously:** Construction of the concrete pavement and finishing work

Some work could occasionally be carried out over the weekend.
