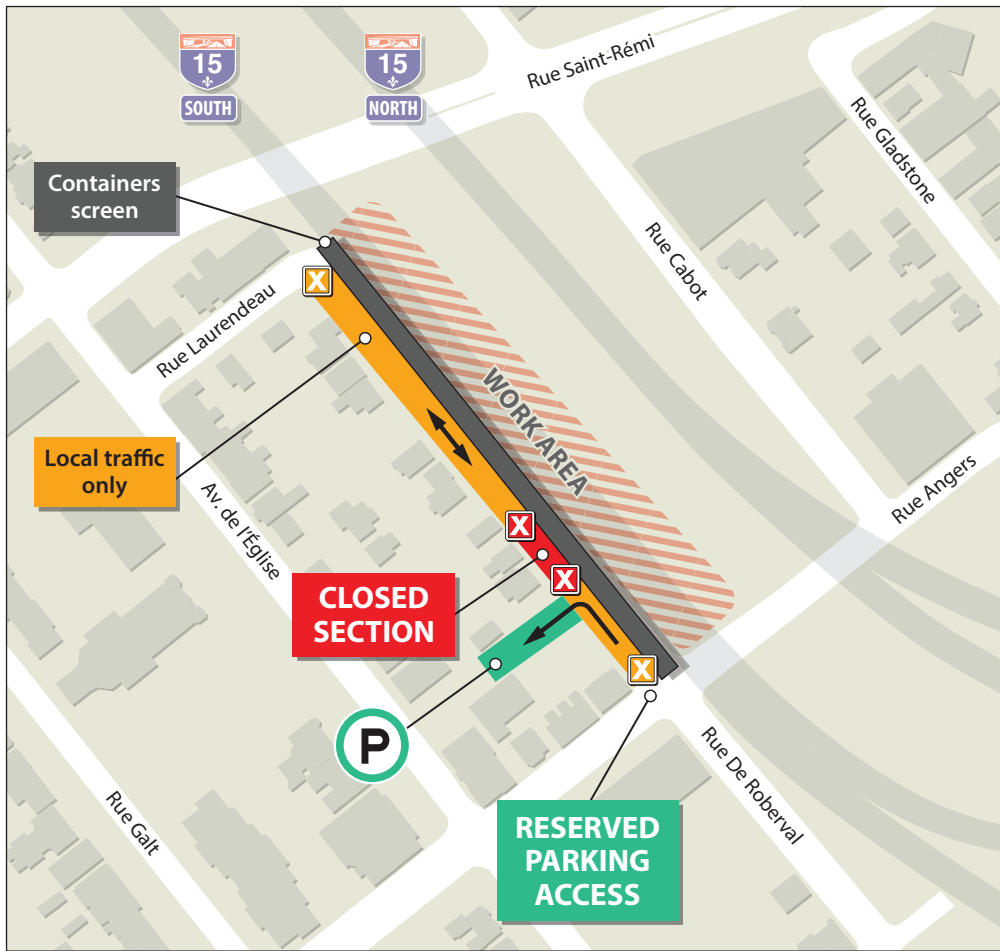


Notice to residents

Le ministère des Transports wishes to inform you that **a section of rue De Roberval will be reopened to local traffic in the week of February 18.**
This configuration will remain in place until the end of March 2019.



Parking

The Parking reserved for residents of rue De Roberval (civic addresses from 1652 to 1740) will remain available until the end of the dismantling work, towards the end of March.

Some residents will have access to their private entrance. A few parking spaces on the street will also be available.

➔ **Please note that the parking will be inaccessible on February 18, 19, 20 and 21, from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.,** in order to move the containers. You must leave the parking lot before 7 a.m., if you have to use your vehicle during these days.

Garbage / Recycling / Compost Collection

Bins must be placed on the edge of the sidewalk, in front of your residence, before 6 a.m. every Thursday. KPH Turcot will move them for collection, then bring them back. Please make sure that your bins are properly identified.
